






National economy

EEA Grants in Greece timeline - progress






Timeline

- o MoU 2009-2014 signing: 2011.
- Launch event: 28 Nov 2013.
- Annual Meetings: 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017.
- MCS at national level: 2014.
- o MCS at programme level: 2015 2016.
- Across programmes, 129 projects were approved and implemented:
 - The projects and programmes managed by <u>FMO</u> were implemented by April **2016**.
 - The projects and programmes managed by the <u>Greek authorities</u> were implemented by April **2017** (except management costs/bilaterals, which ended 31 Dec 2017).
 - For Programme GR 01 eligibility ended for BFNL in 30 Apr 2018 and for Technical Assistance in 31 Aug 2018.



Management - monitoring


- o Participation of NFP in all milestones and events of Programmes.
- o Continuous monitoring through reports, site visits and the EEA Grants DoRIS system.
- National MIS in operation for EEA Grants (ΟΠΣ-ΕΟΧ) :
 - The new national EEA Grants MIS system was delivered in 2016 to the NFP and all users (POs and PPs), further to close cooperation with the Special Service for MIS of the Ministry of Economy & Development.
 - Data was entered into the MIS from all POs and PPs, for all expenditures of 2009-2014 programmes managed by the Greek authorities. This was a requirement under national rules for monitoring (MCS), as well as electronic payment procedures from the state budget.
 - MIS data was used, for the first time, to extract financial reports and audits samples in a systemic manner (ref. Audit Authority).


Final Strategic Report

These results are summarised in the tables that follow:








T.A. – NFP progress








Bilateral Fund at National Level progress

 MCS implementation at national level was audited in the summer of 2018 -for the first time in EEA Grants in Greece- by international independent auditors, on behalf of FMO:
